The 2-nd and the 3-rd letters of the sentence are the 11-th, 12-th and 18-th letters of the key!

The 3-rd letter of the 1-st word (down) or the 2-nd letter of the 2-nd word (across) or the 2-nd letter of the 8-th word (down) are the 14-th and the 21-st letters of the key!

# 4. Do animals speak English? Who says what? (A – Across, D - Down)

(1 point for each word, max 7 points)

The 2-nd letter of the 4-th word (across) is the 1-st and the 3-rd letters of the key!

The 1-st and the last letters of the 3-rd word (across) or the 2-nd letter of the 2-nd word (down) are the 9-th and the 22-nd letters of the key!

# 5. Where do they live? (A – Across, D - Down)

(1 point for each word, max 10 points)

(4 A) kennel (7 A) stable (3 A) hole (9 A) sty

(5 **D**) nest (3 **D**) hive (6 **D**) web (8 **D**) lair (1 **D**) anthill (2 **D**) hollow

The 2-nd letter of the 8-th word (down) is the 14-th and the 21-st letters of the key!

The 3-rd letter of the 3-rd word (down) is the 7-th letter of the key!

#### 6. Choose one word that doesn't fit into the group and say why:

(1 point for each word and 1 point for each explanation, max 12 points)

- 1) wine (because this is a drink)
- 2) bread (because the others are usually sweet)
- 3) onions (because they are the only vegetables)
- 4) slippers (because they are the only footwear on the list)
- 5) burglar (because this is not an occupation)
- 6) magazine (because you can only read this)

The last letters of the 3-rd and 4-th words or the 1-st letter of the 4-th word are the 4-th letter of the key!

#### 7. Something to drink.

**How many names of drinks can you find?** (1 point for each word, max 10 points)

The 1-st letter of the 7-th word is the 13-th and the 19-th letters of the key!

The 6-th letter of the 1-st word or the 2-nd and the 5-th letters of the 2-nd word or the 2-nd and the last letters of the 5-th word or the 5-th letter of the 6-th word or the 2-nd and the 10-th letters of the 9-th word or the 1-st and the 5-th letters of the 11-th word

or the 3-rd letter of the 12-th word are the 6-th, the 8-th, the 16-th and the 20-th letters of the key!

### 11. Modify words!

How do you get from hen to dog, from rat to man, from jam to cup, changing only one letter at a time? (1 point for each word, max 11 points)
